*Certain expenses such as child care, elder care, medical, insurance premiums, and outgoing child support expenses may be deducted from the gross income (income before tax deductions) to determine eligibility. These deductions are calculated differently for CHP+ and Medicaid.

Applicants must be U.S. Citizens or Legal Permanent Residents (for at least 5 years) in order to qualify - some Medicaid exemptions do apply. Parents' citizenship/residency is not considered when determining eligibility for children.
